

Procedures for House District 54 Nominating Meeting

Nominations

An individual may only be placed in nomination by a voting member of the Boyle and Casey County Committees.

Candidate Remarks

If more than one individual is placed in nomination, each candidate will be given up to 3 minutes to address the nominating committee prior to the election of a nominee. The committee will be given up to 5 minutes to ask questions of each candidate separately.

Other nominees will be asked to leave the room and each one will be called individually, in alphabetical order, to address the members of the nominating committee.

Voting Procedure

The election of a nominee will be conducted by secret ballot unless only one individual is placed in nomination.

If more than one individual is placed in nomination, each individual nominated will be asked to appoint a representative to observe the tallying of votes.

An individual must receive greater than 50 percent of the total votes cast to be elected as the Republican Party's nominee. In this case, an individual must receive at least 8,092 of the total 16,183 votes cast.

In the event that more than two individuals are placed in nomination and no candidate receives greater than 50 percent of the votes available, the lowest vote-getter will be dropped from balloting. Balloting will continue in this manner until one candidate receives greater than 50 percent of the vote.

Actual vote totals will not be announced. After a voting round, the Chairman will report whether or not a candidate has exceeded 50 percent of the total votes. If no candidate receives 50 percent of the vote, the Chairman will announce which candidates will proceed to the next round of voting.
